"With upright heart he shepherded them and quided them with his skillful hand." Ps. 78:72

ooking at the life of David, you often think of his kingly pursuits. However, before David was anointed to be king of God's chosen people, he was a shepherd. As a shepherd king, David led and guided God's people in worshipping Him and believing, trusting and having faith in God and His promises.

Brothers and sisters in Christ, David is pointing forward to Jesus and what Jesus would be for God's people. The prophet Micah prophesies this about the Christ: "he shall stand and shepherd his flock in the strength of the Lord, in the majesty of the name of the Lord his God. And they shall dwell secure, for now he shall be great to the ends of the earth."

This Christ that Micah is proclaiming, would provide you with vital shepherd's care. He would release and rescue you from the things that separate you from God, what is holding you in bondage: sin, death and the power of the devil.

Jesus, the Good Shepherd, tells you in John's Gospel, "I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep." Jesus did indeed lay down His life on the cross for you.
