The Ingathering collection area will be near the registration table. The items brought to the LWML

It will help the incarcerated to keep in touch with their families and loved ones. If you have such a place in your area, please pick up a packet of cards to take with you and leave

them at the facility. This will save considerable time and postage.

The paper products and cleaning products will help an abused woman/mother get set up in housekeeping in her own safe place at the Safe Haven Shelter or in Grace Place, both in the Willmar area.

The Servant Events will be held in Gallery 2. Women can sort the greeting cards that are brought in and there will be a representative from the Global Health Ministries to assist in making rolled bandages. These bandages will be sent overseas where they are in demand.

Also, Sharon Skaro, of the Blue Star Mothers of America, will be there to assist us in making fleece ponchos for veterans. This sounds like a most interesting and exciting project. The ponchos made will be distributed to veterans in the area.

Many thanks to these representatives and their organizations for helping us to be of service to many others through these Servant Events.


